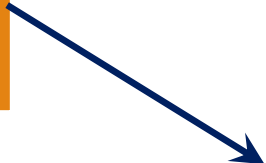

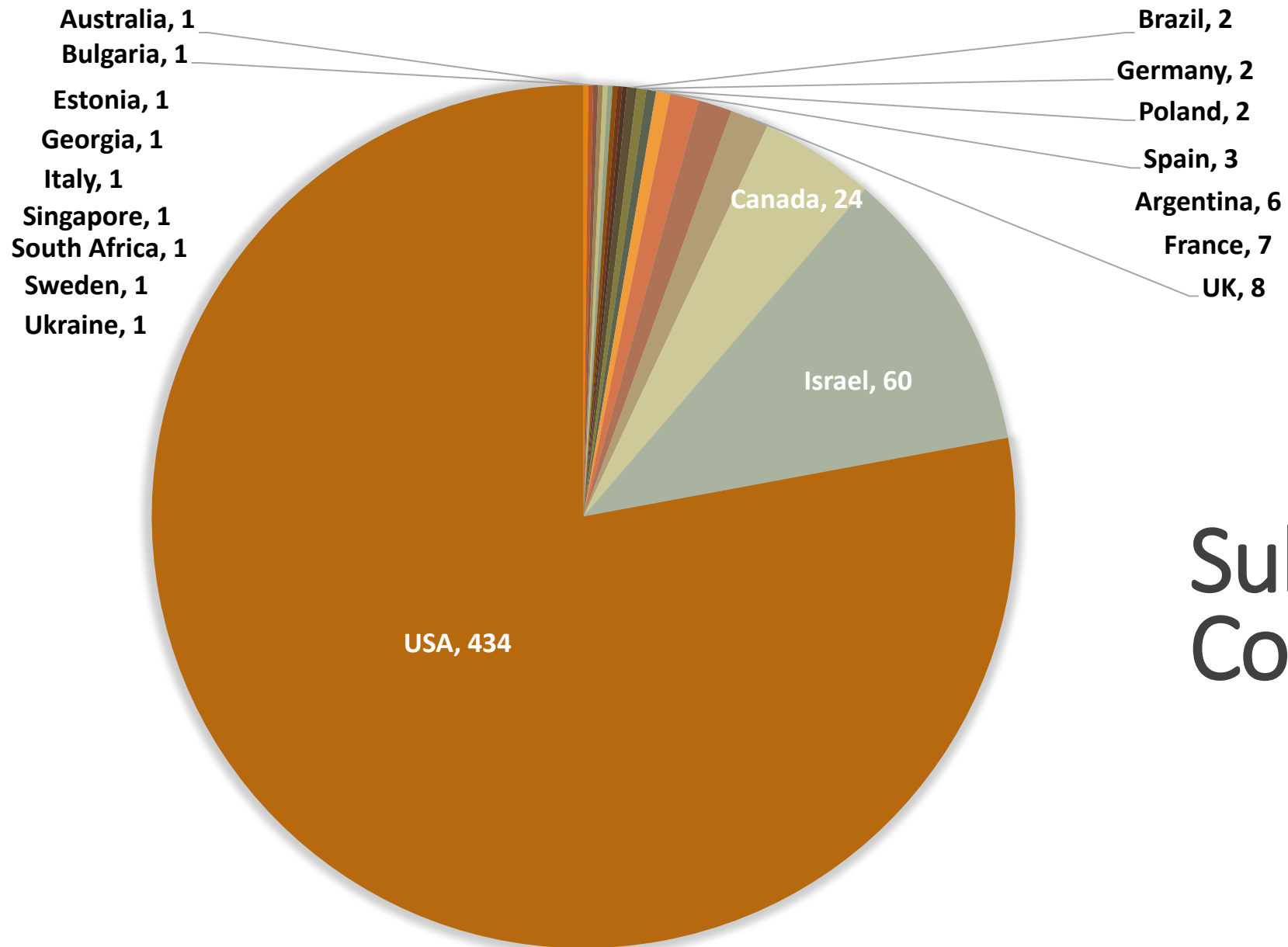

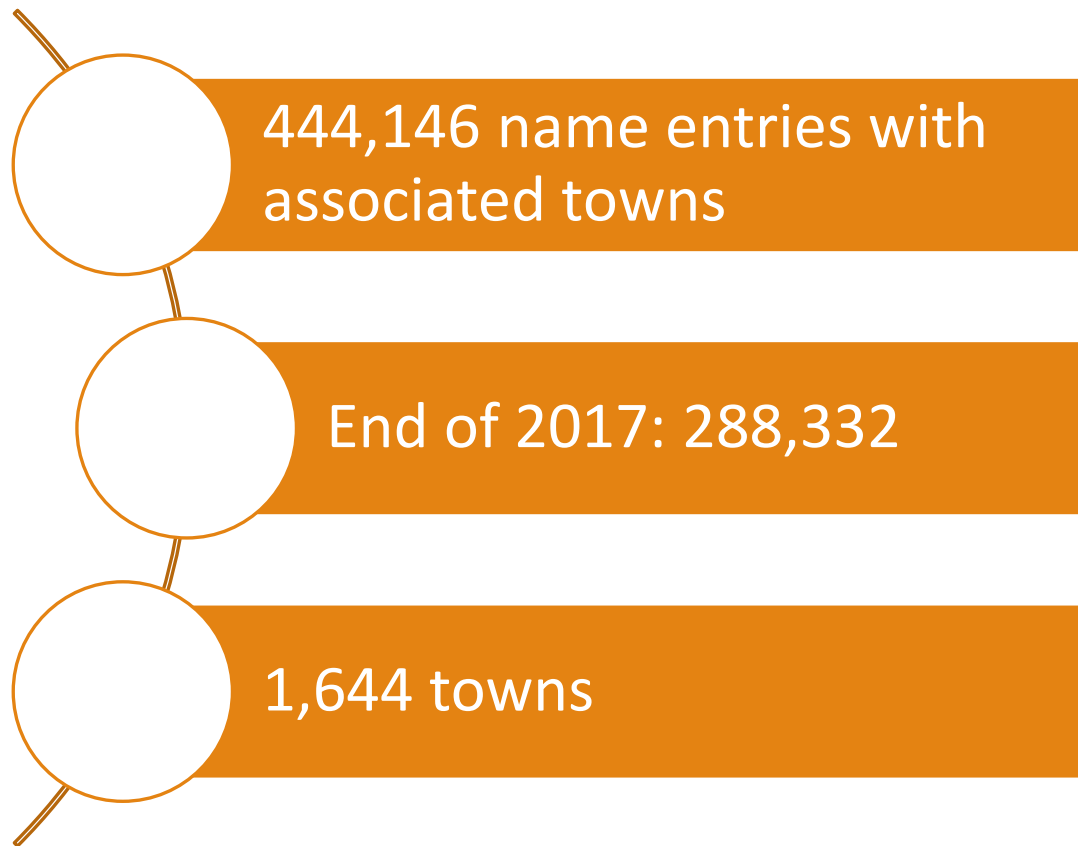

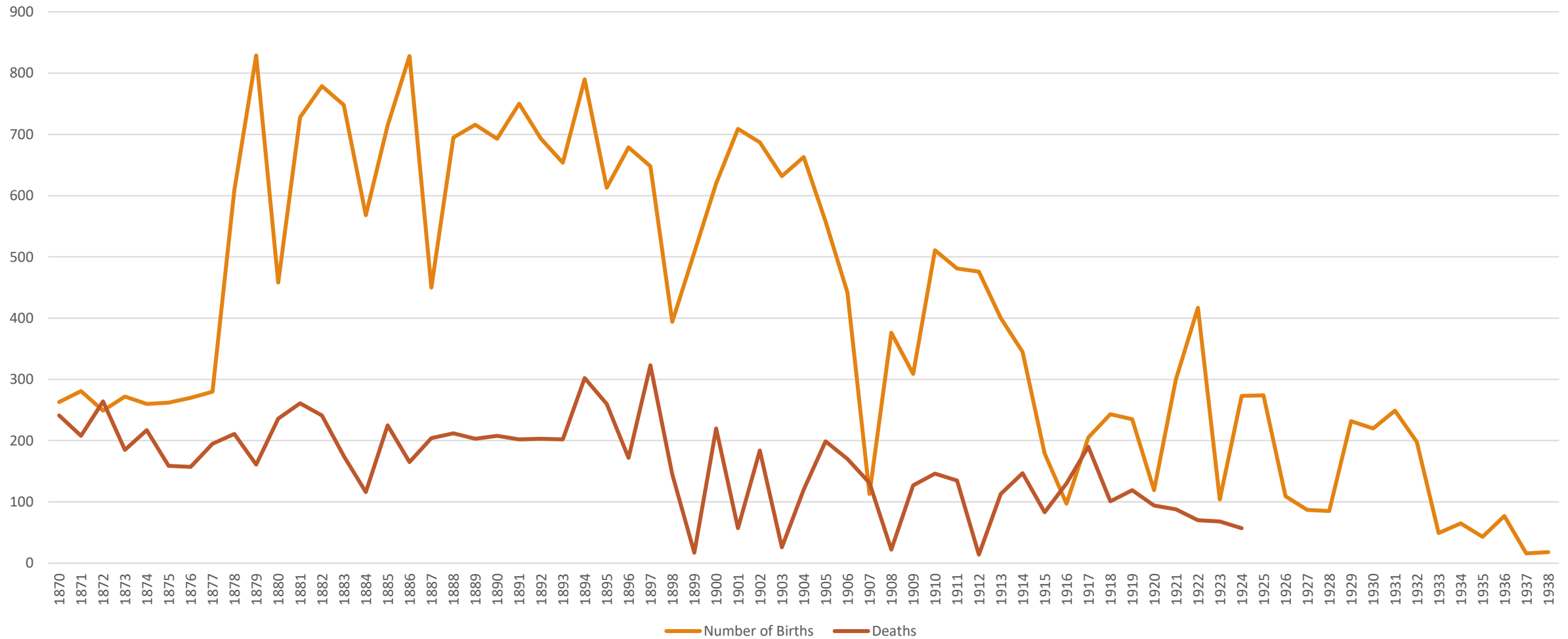
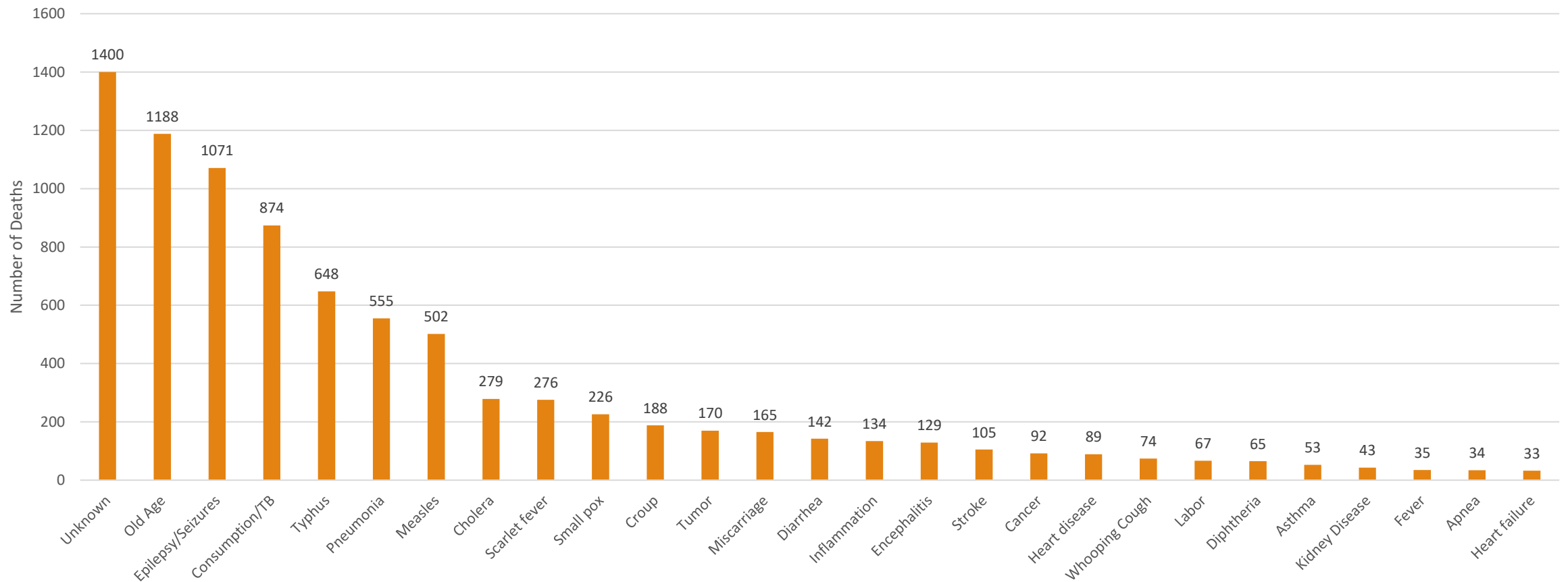


Figure 2: Table of Births by Year for the Period from 1870 through 1938 – Kremenets Jewish Population

Causes of Death - Age 0 to 18

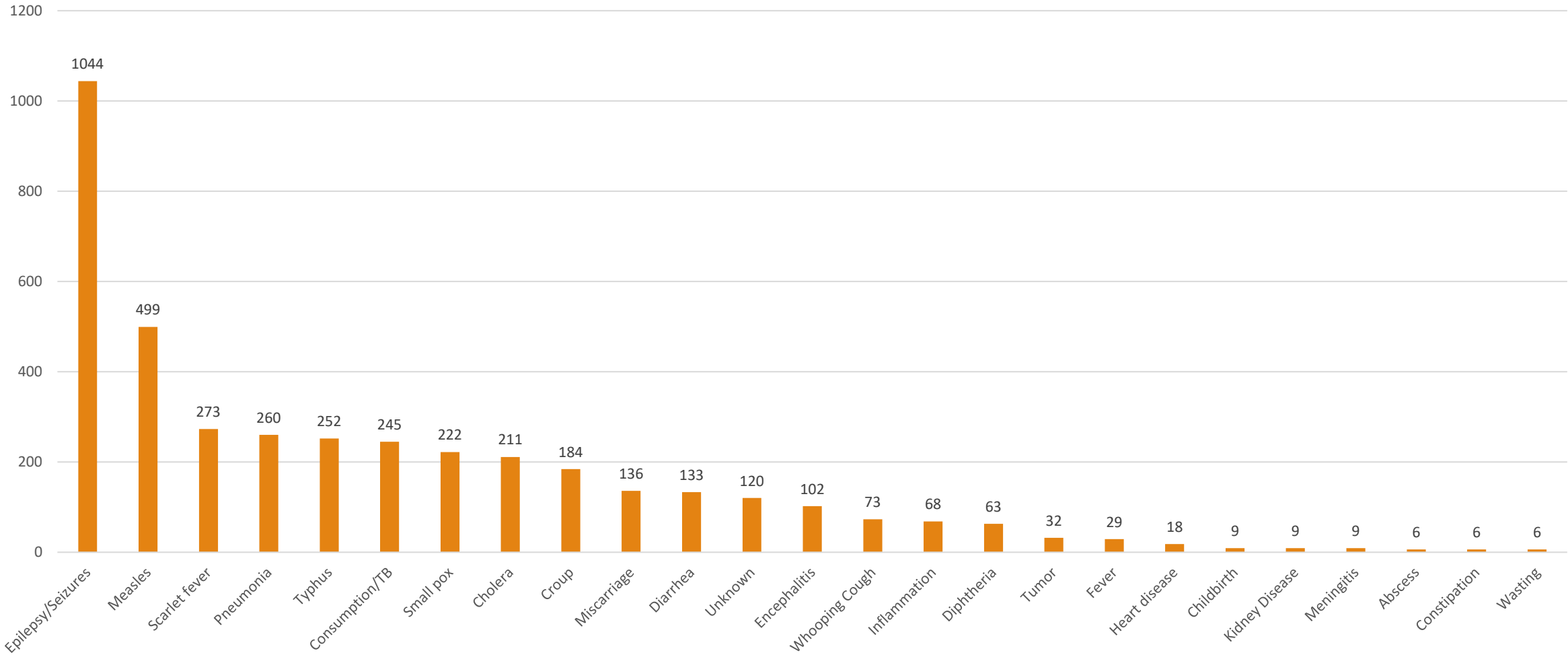


Figure 5a: Leading causes of death by year for the period from 1870 through 1930, Ages 18-up, Jewish Kremenets population

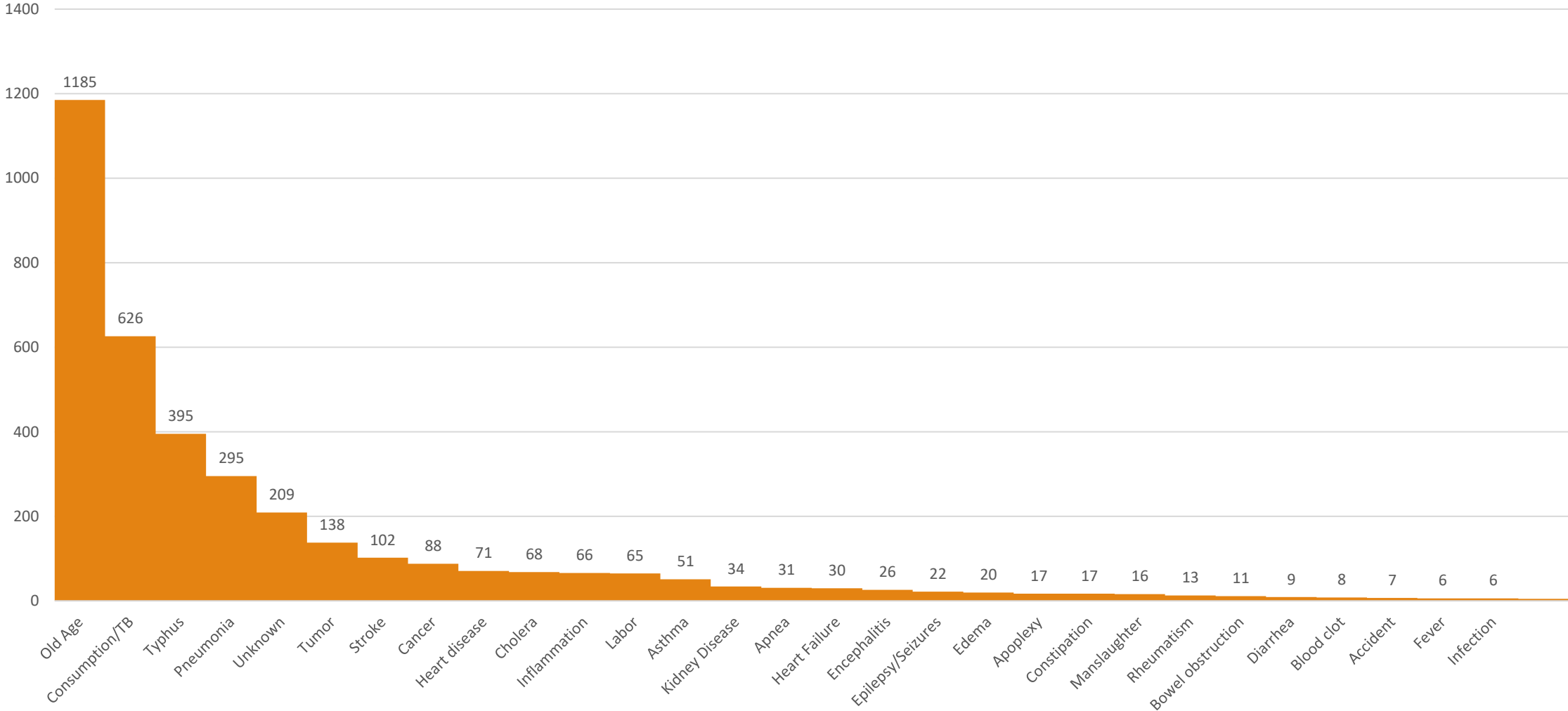


Figure 5b: Analysis of Consumption/TB Deaths by year for the period from 1870 through 1921, All Ages, Jewish Kremenets population

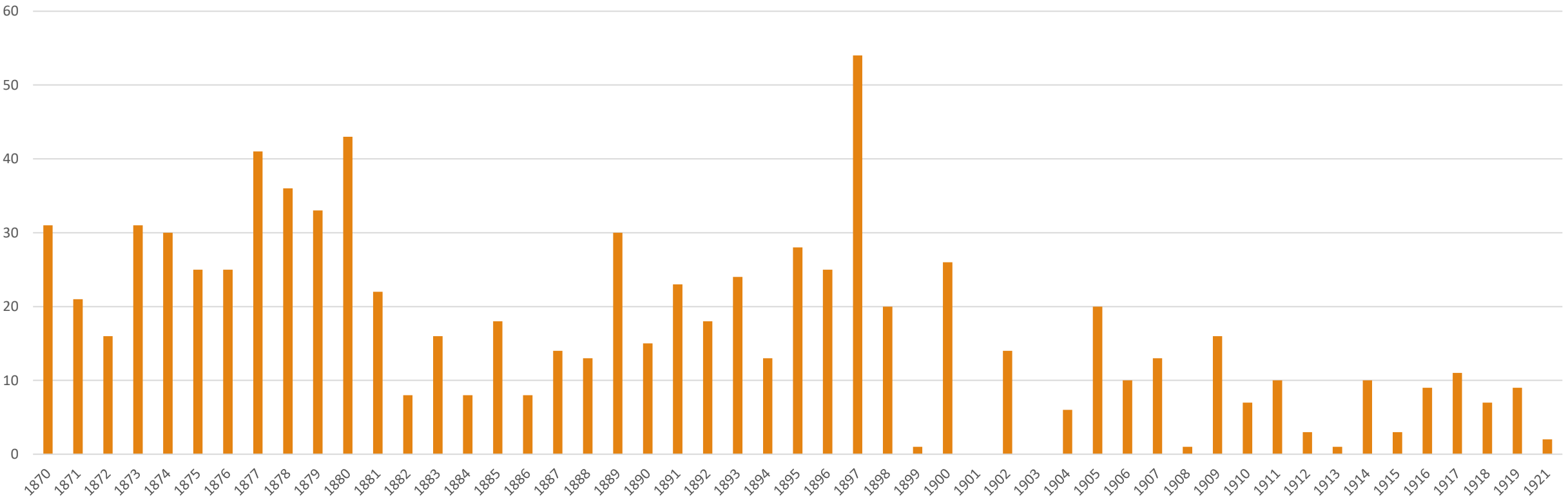
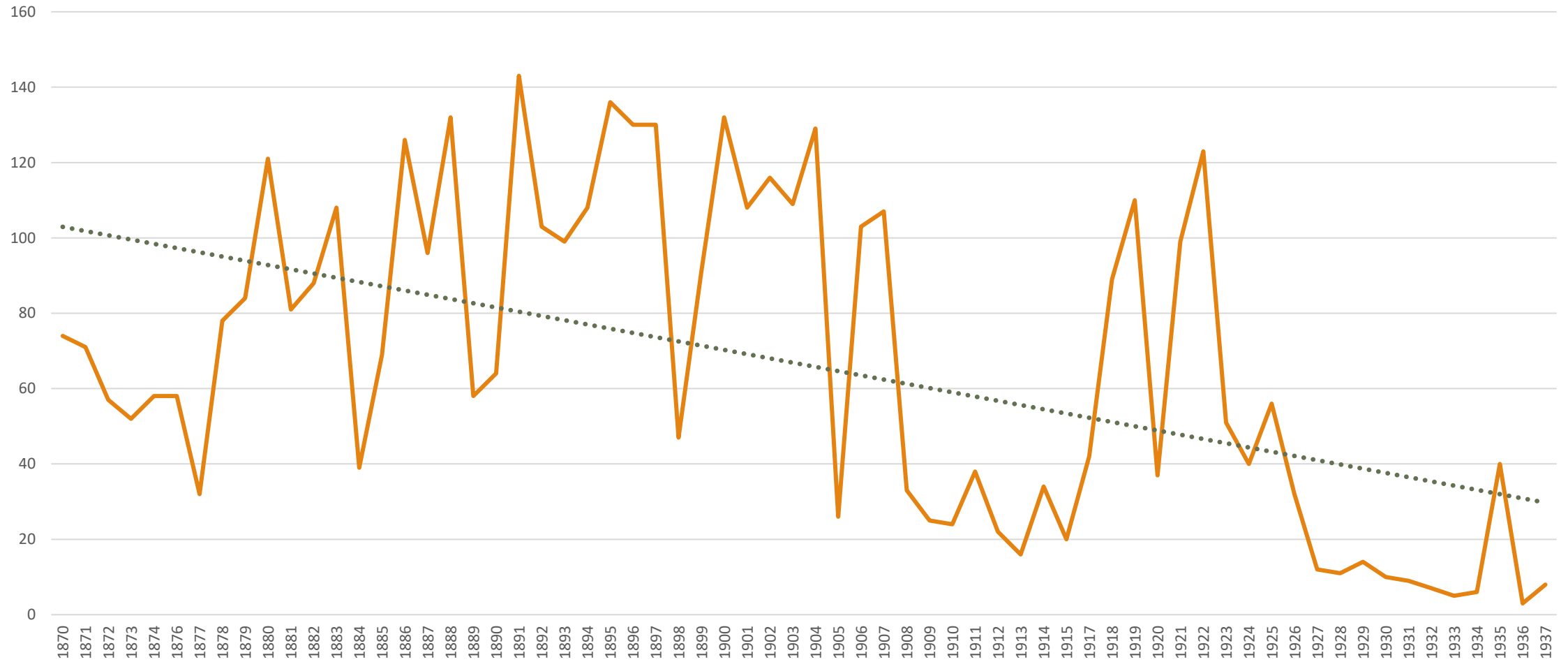


Figure 6: Leading Cause of Death by Year for Kremenets Region (Jewish Population)
