Issued regarding LUVSHIS Vladimir Isaakovich, born in 1923, in the fact that his family consists of:

1. Mother—LUVSHIS Fradl daughter of Vladimir, born 1900
2. Brother—LUVSHIS Motel son of Isaak, born 1926
3. Brother—LUVSHIS Srul son of Isaak, born 1930

¹ The name is Luvshis in the certificate but Lufshis in Freyde's note.

4. Sister—Roza daughter of Isaak, born 1940

During the German occupation of 1941-1943, they lived in the Kozin borough of the Rovno region and were in the German ghetto. His whole family was shot by the Germans in 1942, and their property was confiscated, which is confirmed.
