History of Monessen Lodge No. 776

Thirty Years of B'nai B'rith By Morris H. Samuels

In September, 1915, a group of twenty-six men decided to organize a B'nai B'rith Lodge in the Monongahela Valley, and October, 1915, a charter was granted to the Monongahela Valley Lodge No. 776 B'nai B'rith, with these men, (whose names appear elsewhere in this program) being listed as charter members.

 A_{9} few years later, beautiful lodge room furniture was bought, and I might say, is still the envy of visiting brothers. During the regime of our late Brother, Thomas Bergstein, the largest number of members (25), ever to come into the Lodge at one time, was initiated at a tremendous banquet.

Our Jewish boys organized one of the first A. Z. A. Chapters in Western Pennsylvania, being the eighty-second to enter the fold, in this country. Our A. Z. A. boys had the honor and distinction of having the first A. Z. A. owned home in the world

One of the outstanding events in our history, occurred on October 28, 1934, when Monongahela Valley Lodge played host to the Western Pennsylvania Council, which then consisted of only thirteen lodges. At this banquet we had as guest speaker, Richard E. Gutstadt, Chairman of the Anti-Defamation League.

In 1935 we allowed the Donora members to separate from us, so that they might form their own lodge and thereby add strength to the B'nai B'rith. At this time our name was officially changed to Monessen Lodge B'nai B'rith No. 776. A few years later, the Charleroi members also left us, to form an organization of their own. With all this, we still retained a inembership of (fifty-two) in our own lodge. At present we have a membership of seventy-two.

During World War II, we did everything that was asked of us, and more. All those entering the service were given a gift by the B'nai B'rith and now a beautiful plaque with the rames of those who served in the Armed Services has been purchased, and will shortly be presented to our Community.
